Part of the class time will be spent on the school's Chromebooks to type up good copies of written work. A poster board will be provided to each student to display writing, pictures, and map.

(Type of Community – rural, urban, suburban, mining, manufacturing, tourist, etc.) (**Municipal Services:** How does the community meet the needs of its people?) People need water, so the community provides us with clean drinking water. There are also certain services set up by the city to take care of our garbage, recycling, and sewage. Communities make roads for us to travel on and provide other transportation services/links for us to use (e.g., subways, city busses, light rail,

- etc.). *Be careful not to mix up municipal services with private companies such as movie theatres, grocery stores, arcades, restaurants, etc.)
